"A Place Called Hell"

Just a few weeks ago, everyone knows that my family & I went on vacation aboard a Disney cruise. One of the stops that we made was at the Grand Cayman Islands. It was a beautiful place! Our group rented a driver & took a tour of the island. It was very interesting. One stop we made was in a community by the name of Hell. Yes, this place was named Hell. It even had a post office. The area around this community was known for its black coral limestone. It is believed that because of the abundance of this black coral limestone is where the name came from. Yes, I'll say while we were there that we mailed some postcards & joked around a little about it. But to tell you the truth, I don't believe that I could live in a place with that name. This is not the only place on earth with this name. There is a town in Norway called Hell. There is also a town in Livingston county in Michigan called Hell.

We may have joked about being there, but in reality, Hell is no joking matter. It's a real place that was made for those who reject God. Sadly, too many people only want to talk about Heaven. No one wants to talk about Hell. Why is that? I think it is because many people don't want to believe in it. Some think that an all-loving God would not send people there. Then there are people who think that Hell doesn't last forever. It's a subject that nobody likes. It's not a pleasant place nor is there anything good to say about it. So why should we talk about Hell? Well, here are a few reasons why it is very important that we look at this subject. One reason is that if we don't tell others about Hell, we will not be preaching the whole counsel of God. As Paul said to the Ephesians, "For I have not

shunned to declare to you the whole counsel of God." (Acts 20:27). Jonah 3:2 shows that we have an obligation to preach God's word: all of it, nothing more, nothing less, or anything else. The same Bible that teaches us that God sent His Son to die on the cross for sinners also teaches us that He hates sin & will punish those who choose to live in it.

Hell is also a translation of the word *Gehenna*, which is the Greek form of the Hebrew phrase "Valley of the Son of Hinnom", in the King James Version & the New King James Version of the Bible. The word *Hell* is also used for the words *Sheol* & *Hades*. Now the Valley of Hinnom was located on the west & south of Jerusalem. The Canaanites would worship Baal & the god Molech. They used this place to sacrifice children by burning them to death. Ahaz & Manasseh, kings of Judea, were also guilty of this (2 Chronicles 28:3, 2 Chronicles 33:6). King Josiah put an end to this type of worship. He defiled the valley in order to make it unfit even for pagan worship (2 Kings 23:10). During the time of Jesus, this place was used as a garbage dump for Jerusalem. They used it not only for garbage, but they also would throw the carcasses of dead animals & the bodies of convicted criminals who were put to death in to the valley, too. To control the amount, it had a constant fire burning & maggots eating on rotting flesh. The smell would be unbearable at times. Jesus used this place as an example of what Hell would be like. The word *Gehenna* occurs twelve times in the New Testament. Each time, it was translated as *Hell*, with the exception of James 3:6. It is used by Jesus (Matthew 5:22; Matthew 5:29-30; Matthew 10:28; Matthew 23:15; Matthew 23:33; Mark 9:43; Mark 9:45; Mark 9:47; & Luke 12:5). In Matthew 5:22, Matthew 18:9, & Mark 9:47, *hell* is used with the world fire (hell fire). Mark 9:46 & Mark 9:48 describes it as a place where Jesus repeatedly spoke of outer darkness & a furnace of fire where there will be wailing, weeping, & gnashing of teeth. The book of Revelation describes Hell as a lake of fire burning with brimstone. Revelation 19:20 shows that it's a place prepared for Satan & his

followers. Revelation 20:10b says "and they will be tormented day & night forever & ever."

Another reason to teach about Hell is that if we don't, we will not be following the examples of other Bible preachers who have taught about Hell. These include Moses in Deuteronomy 32:22; Job in Job 26:6; & David in 2 Samuel 22:6, Psalm 9:17, & Psalm 18:5. John called it a bottomless pit in Revelation 9:1-2, Revelation 9:11, Revelation 11:7, Revelation 17:8, Revelation 20:1, & Revelation 20:3.

Another reason that we should teach about Hell is that if I don't, I could go there myself. If I love my fellow man as Christ did, I should want to warn everyone of this terrible place. If I don't teach others, they could end up there. How will others learn if we don't teach them?

Satan wants us to believe that Hell is not real & that God will send no one there. The truth is that Hell is real & made for Satan & his followers. God sends no one to Hell; we make that choice ourselves when we follow Satan instead of Christ. The choice is ours to make. I hope everyone has a great week!
